Length ratings are:

Short rides are less than 70 miles round trip.

Medium rides are between 71 and 150 miles round trip.

Long rides are over 150 miles.

Difficulty ratings are:

Novice rides are local, no highways, not a lot of curves, think demo days ride.

Advanced rides involve either highway speeds and/or some curvy roads.

Expert rides will require your undivided attention as they are very curvy roads, switchbacks, or back roads with possible hazards, think the 3 sisters (FM 335, 336, 337)
