<u>Group Riding reminders/tips</u> – A couple of items to add to the tips for a long ride:

- 1. Bring some cash with you. There are some weird ATMs out there...at least ones that work that you can find. You have to ask yourself though, just how secure is your information in these 3<sup>rd</sup> party, non Bank aligned ATMs for profit?
- 2. If you use a 3<sup>rd</sup> party travel site to make your reservations for vacation travel (like for example the soon to be Lone Star Rally), it might be wise to actually call the hotel/motel not

long after you make your reservations to ensure they honor that travel site and that your reservation is valid. Otherwise, you may not have a place to stay. We have even had issues with the hotel/motels themselves over the last several years especially when these hotels/motels change ownership after you already made a reservation and they won't honor that prior commitment.

- 3. Call the bank(s) that has/have your Credit Card(s). Let them know you will be using them outside of your geographical area. Otherwise, they may suspend access to your card when a charge appears from outside your "comfort zone". Hmmmm, imagine how I know about that. Ok, guilty as charged.
- 4. Your bike has a manual override where you can start your bike without your key fob. Set it up and learn how to use it.
