The chapter ride up to Milwaukee to participate in 'The Hometown Rally', started on 22 July at 05:45 from the HEB gas station on Bandera & 1604. Our ride ended at Caliente Harley Davidson dealership, on 31 July 2024 at 20:30 hours.

Enrique Z. and myself rode the highways and byways around the Ozark mountains of Oklahoma, Arkansas and Missouri. We zipped along the interstate, surrounded by Illinois & Iowa cornfields. We enjoyed the twists & turns of Kettle Moraine State Forest roads, surrounded by 'old stand' Oak, Maple

and Ponderosa Pine trees in southern Wisconsin. We drove through frog choking rains complete with close encounters from Mother Nature's bolts of lightning. We felt the cold waters of Lake Michigan; enjoyed a USAF Thunderbird aerial display; all the outdoor concerts at Veteran's Park, including Red Hot chili Peppers. We toured the Harley-Davidson MC Museum, as-well-as the associated Gift Shop and HD discount (or discontinued) retail store.

An additional venue for the Hometown Rally was an opportunity to take a tour or the H-D Headquarters, located on Juneau Ave. This building is located directly across the street where the original 10x18 shack was, 121 years ago. Our tour of the H-D Powertrain plant was an interesting experience. Then, just for the thrill of it, we did test rides on new 2024 Pan Americans and Road Glides.

We also enjoyed the coziness of spending several nights in an 1890s farmhouse as guests of my sister and brother-in-law.

Lastly, we survived our trek back down the Texas back roads into the oven-like HEAT that had been absent since the middle of our first day.

Our overall route took us through seven States, to five of the 50 for 365 HOG coin rides to include The Talimena Scenic Drive in OK; The Pig Trail in Arkansas; The Ohio River Scenic Roadway including a stop in Metropolis, Illinois to visit Superman; Van Buren County Courthouse and the scenic farmland route in Iowa & the twist and turns around Lake of the Ozarks and Bagnell dam in Missouri. Additionally, we had we made dozens of check-in's at dozens of Harley Davidson dealerships around the states we visited. And rode on the Historic US 66 Byway.
